Meet the Submarines

Our first submarine, project A, was named AMY after the American female Olympic swimmer, and gold medalist Amy Van Dyken. AMY was designed to be a single pilot, human-powered, fixed-pitch propeller based submarine, and competed in the European International Submarine Races (eISR) in the UK in 2016, under the single-seater propeller driven category, and received an award for perseverance. In July of 2017, WatSub returned to the races with BOLT, our second submarine.

BOLT, is named after the Jamaican sprinter and gold medalist Usain Bolt and competed in the International Submarine Races (ISR), hosted by the Naval Surface Warfare Center in Maryland, USA. BOLT participated in the one-person submarine, propeller driven category, like AMY.

WatSub is currently in the manufacturing phase of project C. It boasts and brand-new non-propeller propulsion system and sophisticated electronic controls system. We look forward to putting our designs to the test at the 15th International Submarine Races in June of 2019. The Competition

What would a design team be without a competition to showcase our ingenuity? There are two main competitions: one in the United Kingdom, and the other in the United States. The WatSub team is interested in participating at both; here is a sneak peak at our plans regarding competitions:





International Submarine Race (ISR)

The ISR (www.internationalsubmarineraces.org) is a competition held in Bethesda, Maryland, USA inside the legendary David Taylor Navy Basin. It takes place every two years and is one of the most important competitions, as it has encompassed almost 30 teams from 9 different countries. In ISR, we compete alongside some of the best teams in North America and beyond. It is important to note that the current human powered speed records were set in this competition.

European International Submarine Race (eISR)

The elSR (www.subrace.eu) is held in Gosport, England, in the years that ISR does not run. It also involves teams from all over the world. This competition has its own twist, as they host obstacle course races, testing the navigational ability of the competing submarines. This is where WatSub had its international debut, and where we raced our first submarine, AMY.






Budget
